KCF exists to bring people to a biblical relationship with God and each other and to take responsibility for the well-being of our community both locally and beyond in an environment of love and integrity.

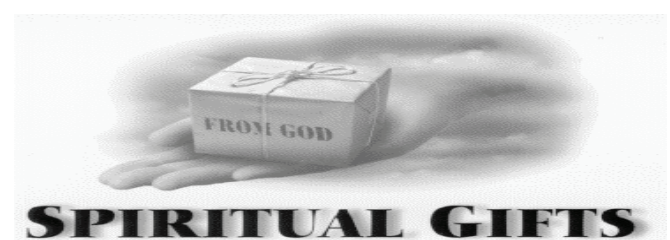
Missions:
